“Take the Tour” at the Lakes

Battle Lake, MN, August 2, 2008 – As families and business professionals consider making the lakes area their home, they have many things to evaluate. Developing a complete view of an area without knowing “who’s who” in the community can be a daunting task, especially within a limited stay in the area or from a remote location. The Lakes Area Development Association (LADA) has taken the mystery and labor out of that process with its “Take the Tour” offering.

Given the heightened publicity and interest in the lakes area, LADA team members structured a tour to familiarize people to our area in an effective and streamlined manner. A brief questionnaire is completed by those interested in a tour, which allows planners to arrange relevant stops that are tailored for each visitor.

Depending on the preferences noted in the questionnaire, a tailored tour will be determined from a selection of stops, including: City Hall, School District 542, Royal Auditorium, Glendalough State Park, Art of the Lakes, Lakes Area Community Center, Good Samaritan Assisted Living, local churches, Thumper Pond, Balmoral, Phelps Mill, our area lakes, and the Wildlife Management Areas south of Battle Lake. Each of the venues will feature key attributes and prepared messages delivered by representatives at the venue (such as the Park Manager or School Superintendent / Principal).

Additionally, depending upon real estate needs, the tour will include stops at available residential, lakeshore, and commercial properties represented by LADA’s member realtors.
